

**Executive Instructions on Accreditation of Representatives of Lists
of Electoral District of 2024**

**Issued Under Provisions of The Independent Election Commission Law No. (11) of
2012 – Article No. (12) And Provisions of Parliamentary Election Law No. (4) Of
2022 – Article No. (72)**

Article No. (1) Present Instructions are to be titled: “Executive Instructions on Accreditation of Representatives of Lists of Electoral District of 2024” which Instructions to come into effect as from the publication date thereof in Official Gazette.

Article No. (2)

- A- For the Purposes of present Instructions, a representative means a representative of either a local list or a party list.
- B- Definitions mentioned herein shall, wherever they are mentioned, have the same meanings assigned thereto in Parliamentary Election Law.

Article No. (3)

- A- A representative shall, in order to be accredited, fulfill the following Conditions:
 - 1. He/She is a Jordanian citizen.
 - 2. He/She is 18 years old at least, on the date he applies for accreditation.
 - 3. He / She is not accredited as an observer by any observation body.
- B- For each local or party list, no more than one representative is to be assigned for each polling and counting station.
- C- A party list and a local list may, for each polling and counting station, agree upon accrediting one representative for them both.

Article No. (4) Representatives are to be accredited as follows:

A- A delegate of a party and local list may; by lodging the form approved by the Board for that purpose starting from admission date of application form of running for the list and for fifteen days prior to the date fixed for polling; apply for accreditation of representatives thereof, for said representatives to be able to enter polling and counting stations and observe electoral process.

B1 – A list representatives accreditation application form is to be submitted by party list delegate to the electoral committee of the general Electoral District of the Commission.

B2 - A list representatives accreditation application form is to be submitted by local list delegate to the electoral committee of the general Electoral District of the Commission.

- C- The following Documents are to be attached to representatives accreditation application form:
 - 1. A list that contains names and personal photos of representatives.
 - 2. A photocopy of ID card of each representative.
- D- Fulfillment by representatives' accreditations application forms of stipulations contained in Articles No. (3) Herein is to be verified by the competent electoral committee, which verification results to be submitted through Operations Directorate to the Board for approval.
- E- Accreditation cards of representatives who are accredited, are to be issued by Operations Directorate using the form approved for that purpose by the Board, then are delivered to lists delegates through competent electoral committee, within the period fixed by the Board.

Article No. (5) Application of accreditation termination of any list representative may, by list delegate, be submitted to either the competent electoral committee or any branch thereof, provided that the accreditation card of the representative that the accreditation of which is terminated is to be delivered to the committee.

Article No. (6) A special area is to be assigned for representatives, in order to ensure the integrity of electoral process, fulfillment of spatial requirement of polling and counting stations and the confidentiality of voting process; where each list may, inside any single station, be presented by no more than one representative.

Article No. (7) Representatives shall, under accountability, adhere to:

- A- Provisions of Constitution and legislations regulating electoral process.
- B- Bear and apparently show accreditation card during their presence inside polling and counting stations, where any person lacks the said card and the id card shall have no access to polling and counting stations.
- C- Refrainment from bearing any type of weapons including the licensed ones.
- D- Presence inside polling and counting stations that contains the box assigned thereto.
- E- Directions of directors of electoral committee, directors and members of polling and counting committees and polling and counting stations while refraining from affecting or attempting to affect choices of voters and from hindering electoral process by any means.

- F- Refrainment from exercising any electoral propaganda or say or act in any manner that might affect the will of voters inside polling and counting centers.
- G- Refrainment, totally, from using cell phones inside polling and counting stations.

Article No. (8)

Representatives during polling and counting day may:

- A- Be present in related places inside polling and counting stations, to follow up polling and counting process.
- B- Sign, at their will, minutes prepared by polling and counting committees.
- C- Witness opening and sealing procedures of polling boxes.
- D- Submit objections regarding violation of polling and counting procedures as set out in Election Law and present Instructions, using the form (executed in three counterparts) that is approved for that purpose; where polling and counting committee is to deliver to the representative its decision whether to sustain or overrule such objections.
- E- Witness inside polling and counting stations, the counting of votes each list and candidate gained as regulated by the Commission.

Article No. (9)

The Board is to approve forms required to apply Provisions of foregoing Instructions.

Article No. (10)

Executive Instructions on Accreditation of Representatives and Delegates of Lists and Candidates of Electoral District No. (8) Of 2016 as amended, are canceled.
